Abstract Submission:

We invite submissions of papers for reporting empirical research, systematic reviews of the literature, as well as theoretical and practical demonstrations. Practitioner-focused proposals in the following non-exhaustive but indicative areas are also invited:

- educational technology
- genre and discipline specificity
- teaching reading, writing, listening, speaking
- development of teaching materials
- teaching methodology
- inter-disciplinary writing
- corpus concordancing
- writing for publication
- reflective academic writing
- teaching in multi-cultural contexts

Potential presenters are requested to submit an abstract of their oral presentation on any aspect of E.A.P., E.S.P. and A.L.

Abstracts should meet the following submission guidelines:

- Abstracts must be completely anonymous and written in English.
- Abstracts are limited to one page using 2,5cm margins on all sides and 12pt Times New Roman font size. The one-page limit includes any examples, tables, graphs, references (if needed), etc.
- The submission type field must be entered by indicating whether your submission should be considered for an oral presentation, a poster, or both.

Please note that all oral presentations will be 20 minutes long, followed by 5 minutes of discussion.

Plenary talks:

Each plenary talk is allocated 30 minutes presentation time followed by 10 minutes discussion time.

Papers in regular sessions and workshops:

Papers are allocated 20 minutes presentation time followed by 5 minutes discussion time.

Poster Guidelines:

Posters should be set to A0 size or smaller. In particular, the allowed dimensions are either 0.84m (Width) x 1.19m (Height) or 0.8m (Width) x 1.2m (Height).

Suggested weight for A0 per square meter: 140gr for plotter paper; 175 gr for photographic paper.
